### Blind Artist and Author Nancy Land McCurtin Redefines Vision with Launch of "BlindBrush&Pen" and New Book Series

**HAMPSTEAD, NC** – In 2016, local artist Nancy Land McCurtin woke up to a world of total darkness. A sudden, massive stroke caused a central retinal vein occlusion, stripping away her eyesight in an instant. For a lifelong creator, the loss was catastrophic—but it wasn't the end of her story.

Today, McCurtin is announcing the expansion of **BlindBrush&Pen**, a studio born from the belief that creativity is a spiritual faculty, not just a visual one. Using a unique "tactile painting" method involving pins, strings, and specialized textures, McCurtin has successfully transitioned from painting what she sees to painting what she feels.

*"I didn't lose my vision; I only lost my sight,"* says McCurtin. *"The brush didn't fall from my hand; it just found a new way to move across the canvas."*

In addition to her fine art, McCurtin has authored the **Topsey** book series—an inspiring collection of children's stories featuring a blind sea turtle. The series serves as an allegory for her own journey, teaching young readers about resilience, kindness, and navigating life's "deep waters" with courage.

#### Highlights of Nancy Land McCurtin's Work Include:

- **Tactile Fine Art:** Original works created through a multi-sensory process that invites the viewer to experience art through a new lens.
- **The Topsey Series:** Children's literature designed to foster empathy and inclusion for the visually impaired community.
- **Community Advocacy:** As the founder of the Trellis Art Center, McCurtin continues to be a pillar of the Hampstead arts community, proving that disability does not mean a lack of ability.

McCurtin is currently available for interviews, keynote speaking engagements, and live painting demonstrations to share her message of "Sight to Insight."

Nancy Land McCurtin is a Hampstead-based artist, author, and stroke survivor. Through her brand, BlindBrush&Pen, she documents her journey of reclaiming her creative life after total vision loss. Her mission is to inspire others to find their "inner vision" regardless of the obstacles they face.
